The Encore Fund

How can you contribute?

The Turner Centre invites individuals or organisations to pledge a contribution payable over a period of three years. Annual contributions accumulated will go towards the annual operational costs. The three year payment period helps provide stability to the Centre and is very helpful with operational funding.

3 levels of contribution

Encore Platinum

\$5,000 or more per year for three years.

Encore Gold

Up to \$5,000 per year for three years.

Encore Silver

\$1,000 to \$3,000 per year for three years.

Endowment Gifts

The Turner Centre has established an Endowment Account for individuals or companies wishing to contribute \$10,000 or more in cash or kind. Funds are invested, and the principal will not be touched. Contributions can be in the form of cash, shares and bonds, property, insurance policies, and other marketable assets. Your gift will keep giving in perpetuity. An enduring legacy to help ensure the long-term viability of the Turner Centre.

Bequests

Bequeathing all or a portion of your estate to support the Centre is an effective way to leave a lasting legacy, and to sustain the Centre's work.
